

WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY

Today we celebrate a time in the life of the Church that I never knew existed, until I was in seminary and on staff at Northside UMC in Atlanta. It's World Communion Sunday. It's a special Sunday in the United Methodist Church, where we pause to acknowledge the Church around the world.

We can all get pretty limited in our vision. Church becomes my local church. We may notice the district, if we're involved with a District Camp, or even the Annual Conference. It seems most United Methodists are aware of the General Church, because of all of the publicity around United Methodist issues. But this is bigger than that.

We're talking about Christ's Church – across denominations, and around the world! What we refer to each Sunday as the holy catholic church. That isn't referring to the Roman Catholic Church. The word catholic means "Universal," and it is said in that context in the Apostle's Creed – "I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints..." We are acknowledging that the Church of Jesus, is a whole lot bigger than just our local church, our denomination. It is His Church around the world.

Next month we'll celebrate All Saints day and remember those we've lost to death. And in that, we'll lift up the next line of the Creed – "the communion of saints." Christ's Church is all the believers, around the world, and across time! Praise God!
