Last Sunday I preached on the Parable of the Unmerciful Servant, and I talked about how we are called to forgive others. I admitted my own struggles with this, and talked about how those closest to you could hurt you the most, because you had higher expectations for them. That is true in your family, and it is true in the life of a church. There is a reason that so many people who feel like they have been hurt or offended in church, or by church members don't just leave a church, but leave The Church.

In that process of putting up walls, they put themselves in a box where they won't be hurt again, and unfortunately that hurt becomes their identity. If you know someone who has shut themselves off from church because of something that happened in a church, encourage them to realize they are isolating themselves. Invite them to come back into the fellowship of believers – if not at the church they had been attending, then at another one.
