Today, we will join in with Methodists from all over the world, as we celebrate John Wesley's Covenant Service. As we go through this service, I hope you'll take time to reflect that Methodists have been participating in this service since 1755. The heart of the service is focused in on Wesley's Covenant Prayer, and it allows us the opportunity to commit or recommit ourselves to God, as well as to renew our commitment to Christ and the Church at the start of the year.

John Wesley's Covenant Service

On December 26, 1747, John Wesley strongly urged the Methodists to renew their covenant with God. He eventually held his first Covenant Service on August 11, 1755. The service has since moved to, and has traditionally been held on, the first Sunday in the New Year. I experienced my first Wesley Covenant Service in St. Anne's Bay, Jamaica, when I was there on a mission trip in 1990. My second one was when Reverend Sam Rogers came to Tifton and did his first Covenant Service here in 1996. Over the years, I have shared this service with each congregation I've served.

Following the Covenant Service, we will celebrate Holy Communion, as we get our New Year headed in the right direction.
