

Welcome Ty Kinslow

We're delighted to have Ty Kinslow sharing with us in the traditional sevices this morning. Ty is the Senior Vice President for Communications for Magnolia Manor, the South Georgia Conference of the United Methodist Church's ministry to older adults.

In the late '50's, the Conference commissioned an internal study on the needs of the elderly in South GA. The study identified the need for safe, secure housing, along with long-term care for the elderly. Magnolia Manor evolved from the Conference's commitment to establish a ministry to meet these needs.

A group of Americus citizens who had formed a foundation to oversee a bequest of 392 acres to provide a home for the elderly, deeded the land to Magnolia Manor. And in 1963, the Manor opened its doors in Americus. Since then, the Americus Campus has continued to expand as campuses were added in Macon in 1983, and then in Richmond Hill, Columbus, Moultrie, St. Marys, Buena Vista, St. Simons Island, and Midway.

One of the greatest ministries of Magnolia Manor is the Good Samaritan Fund, which ensures that no one will have to leave the Manor because of an inability to pay.

I've witnessed firsthand the ministry of the Manor across South Georgia. I was at the groundbreaking of the Moultrie campus, and have had church or family members in the facilities in Americus, Macon, Columbus, Moultrie, and Buena Vista. Some of you may remember that Dr. David Duck and his wife Mary Lee moved to the Manor in Americus.

My Mom made the decision to move to the independent living section in Macon after her dementia diagnoses. She was in the duplexes there until she moved to the rehab facility, and then to the assisted living section in Columbus. She returned to Macon to be in the assisted living section until she had to make the transition to the memory unit in Americus, followed by the rehab and nursing units in Americus. We were truly blessed by the people who looked after her, knowing she was in a safe place with loving people.

Ty joined the Manor team in July of 2020 and is responsible for overseeing public and media relations, marketing, fundraising, church relations, and spiritual care programs for the organization. Thanks to Ty for being with us today.
