

#### Word Studies

Do you know what a Word Study is in Bible Study? It's where you take a concordance and look up all of the usages of a particular word in the Bible. It's a great way to do a deeper Bible study, that looks at a particular word.

This past week I was just done with all of the conflicting reports that I was hearing about everything under the sun – from politics, to wars, to other news events. It is hard to get a factual, unbiased report on anything. As I was talking to God about just wanting to hear the truth – I thought about the God of Truth (Ps. 31:5), the One who said that He was the Truth (John 14:6), the Spirit of Truth (John 14-16), and I thought about the Word of Truth (Eph 1:13, Col 1:5, Jas 1:18). I was reminded of the Belt of Truth (Eph 6:14), and that the Church is to be the pillar and foundation of the truth (1 Tim 3:15).

I did a quick Word Study on Truth. I never had realized that Jesus said, "I tell you the truth..." thirty times in Matthew's Gospel alone. Of course, we are to know the truth, believe the truth, speak the truth, love the truth, and walk in the truth.

When you find yourself upset with all of the false narratives that you hear, and long to find something, anything factual — it might be a great time to pull out a concordance and look up the scripture references for where God used the word "truth" in His Word.
