

Tommy went back to work to make sure every "i was dotted and t was crossed." He became the point person in dealing with our attorney, maintaining a checklist of what we needed to do, and documenting EVERYTHING that we might need.

We also want to thank the South Georgia Annual Conference's leadership that kept its word, and helped churches get to where they felt like they needed to be. We pray that they find relief too.
