

# Resolutions

Every year we tend to think about what we're going to do differently for the new year, and usually we don't follow through. A lot of folks think about losing weight, about fitness, about health, about organization or finances. Many folks don't seem to think a lot about their spiritual lives.

This morning, I hope you'll stop and think about how you want to grow in your spiritual life during the upcoming year. Are there new practices you can incorporate into your routine — a time for prayer, a time for study, participating in a Bible Study, or making worship attendance more of a priority?

I pray this year you will help us to be intentional about sharing not only the love of Jesus, but the truth of who Jesus calls us to be! I hope you will help us be the Discipleship Church in Tifton, where lives are always being impacted for eternity!
