

The area is very poor and many families find it impossible to meet these requirements. Our gifts have been essential. The local economy is impacted, as well, because it is the local businesses which produce the uniforms, shoes, and bread. In addition, school supplies and drinks are purchased locally. Dr. Njoroge's Christian ministry has been crucial in providing many needs of the school community. It has made a tremendous impact in a largely Muslim area.
