

Pentecost

The Israelites were to celebrate the Feast of Weeks, a show of joy and thankfulness for the Lord's blessing of the harvest, as they offered their offerings, including the firstfruits of the wheat harvest. God told Moses, - 15 "From the day after the Sabbath, the day you brought the sheaf of the wave offering, count off seven full weeks. 16 Count off fifty days up to the day after the seventh Sabbath, and then present an offering of new grain to the Lord. 17 From wherever you live, bring two loaves made of two-tenths of an ephah of fine flour, baked with yeast, as a wave offering of firstfruits to the Lord. (Lev 23:15-21)

In the year of Jesus' Resurrection, the day they brought the sheaf of the wave offering would have been the day of Firstfruits. That was the day that became the first Easter – the day Jesus rose from the dead! That year, Jesus was crucified on Passover and raised on Firstfruits.

And seven weeks later, when the Israelites had again assembled in Jerusalem for the Feast of Weeks, the Holy Spirit came. The New Testament name for the Feast of Weeks was "Pentecost." It means fifty and is in reference to fifty days after the Sabbath before the Day of Firstfruits. With the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and what many consider the birth of the Church, Pentecost took on a whole new meaning for the Christians.

Today, seven weeks after Easter, we celebrate Pentecost Sunday!
